Western language	EBSCO (ASP+BSC)	<p>ASP (Academic Search Premier) is the world's largest multidisciplinary full-text database covering diverse academic research areas. Many of the full-text journals included in this database are also indexed in the three major citation databases of the Institute for Scientific Information (ISI) in the United States, namely the Science Citation Index Expanded (SCIE), Social Sciences Citation Index (SSCI), and Arts and Humanities Citation Index (A&HCI). This database is widely used by international academic research institutions and covers a diverse range of academic research areas, including politics, business and economics, information science, technology, communication, engineering, education, art, literature, linguistics, medicine and women's studies, nursing, humanities and social sciences, with more than twice as many journals as the popular ASE database. It indexes/abstracts nearly 8,420 publications (of which approximately 6,879 are peer-reviewed) and provides access to about 4,459 full-text publications (of which approximately 3,619 are peer-reviewed) that are updated monthly. The database also provides high-quality, searchable (native) PDF full-text format files.</p> <p>BSC (Business Source Complete) is one of EBSCO's most comprehensive full-text databases of business and finance. It provides access to more than 10,000 full-text publications and is widely subscribed to and extensively used by leading business schools at major U.S. universities, including Harvard University, Stanford University, the University of Chicago, Northwestern University, and the University of Pennsylvania (Wharton).</p> <p>The database also includes 55 newly added Harvard Business School seminar videos, featuring lecture-based discussion courses presented by distinguished scholars and faculty members from Harvard Business School.</p>
Western language	Journal Citation Reports (JCR)	<p>Journal Citation Reports (JCR) is a web-based journal citation evaluation and statistical database produced by Clarivate (USA). It provides citation-based metrics and journal impact reports for more than 22,000 journals from over 110 countries, covering 254 subject categories in the sciences, social sciences, arts and humanities, as well as regional and emerging research areas.</p> <p>JCR covers a wide range of disciplines, including science, engineering, medicine, agriculture, anthropology, history, law, linguistics, psychology, political science, and sociology. Users may browse or search journals by subject category, publisher, country/region, journal title, or ISSN, and may also view all journals within a specific edition.</p> <p>The database is updated annually in early July with data from the previous year. JCR helps users evaluate the academic impact and performance of journals by subject, year, or country, and serves as an essential reference tool for libraries, publishers, journal editors, and researchers in the selection, management, and use of scholarly journals.</p>
Western language	Primal Pictures 3D interactive human anatomy database	<p>The Primal Pictures 3D Interactive Anatomy database is published by Informa UK Limited, based in the United Kingdom. It includes modules such as 3D ATLAS, 3D Real Time, Functional Anatomy and Therapy, Anatomy & Physiology, Imaging, Clinical Specialties, and Quizzes. These modules provide information on basic physiology, anatomical images, and detailed anatomical descriptions, as well as guidance on ultrasound, MRI, and CT medical image interpretation. The database also includes clinical topics such as dentistry, speech and language therapy, physiotherapy, sports medicine, surgery, and acupuncture. The Primal Pictures Anatomy database provides diverse materials to offer professional basic and clinical medical information, which facilitates clinical work and self-learning for educators. The 3D Real Time module also provides an app function for easy accessibility to learning.</p>

Western language	ProQuest Central	ProQuest Central is one of the most comprehensive multidisciplinary research databases available. It integrates forty-seven best-selling core full-text databases and provides indexing and abstracts for approximately 34,110 publications, including around 26,300 full-text titles. Covering more than 500 subject areas, its content spans business, science, health and medicine, social sciences, general studies, news, and the arts. The database offers a wide range of content types, including doctoral and master's theses, case studies, scholarly journals, newspapers, research reports, and working papers.
Western language	Science Direct Online (SDOL)	This database collects full-text electronic journals published by Elsevier, covering topics such as agriculture, biology, biochemistry, genetics, molecular biology, immunology, microbiology, chemistry, chemical engineering, medicine, pharmacy, pharmaceuticals, dentistry, veterinary medicine, computer science, earth and planetary sciences, engineering, energy, technology, environmental science, materials science, mathematics, physics, astronomy, management, accounting, psychology, business, economics, econometrics, finance, social sciences, arts and humanities, etc. The full-text download is only available online for electronic journals subscribed by our institution through the SDOL platform.
Western language	Turnitin plagiarism detection system	<p>Turnitin is a text similarity detection system that compares submitted papers against a vast database, including 47.7 billion internet pages, 190 million academic publications from Crossref, and 1.9 billion student papers. This comparison helps detect similarities and allows both students and instructors to assess whether a work upholds academic integrity and maintains originality.</p> <p>Turnitin serves two main purposes. First, it is used in classroom teaching, where students upload their reports, assignments, or theses, and receive a similarity report. Instructors can review these reports to provide timely feedback, helping students improve their academic writing skills. Second, Turnitin allows all students, educators and researchers to check the similarity of their academic writing, helping identify potential plagiarism or improper citation, and encouraging students to produce original work.</p>

The collection includes periodicals from Taiwan, Mainland China, Hong Kong, and other global locations that primarily use the Chinese language, but not limited to this language.</p> <p>CETD collects Master's and doctoral theses primarily in the Chinese language from higher education institutions in Taiwan, Mainland China, Hong Kong, and Macau."</p>
