

Regulations for the Training and Management of Work-study Students for Campus Website Maintenance at I-Shou University

Promulgated with the consent from the President dated on January 28, 2018

- Article 1 The Regulations for the Training and Management of Work-study Students for Campus Website Maintenance at I-Shou University (hereinafter referred to as “the Regulations”) are made by I-Shou University (hereinafter referred to as “the University”) with the aim of improving the overall quality of campus websites and maximizing the learning effectiveness of work-study students.
- Article 2 The work-study students mentioned herein refer to those who are hired under the budget of the University to maintain campus websites after having undergone training provided by the Office of Library and Information Services (hereinafter referred to as “the Office”) and satisfying the evaluation criteria established by the Office.
- Article 3 The Office offers work-study students hands-on training sessions on a regular basis, whether face-to-face or online, to assist them in learning web skills and satisfying the criteria.
- Article 4 The Office carries out a performance evaluation twice a semester. The list of work-study students who have passed the evaluation will be announced on the Office’s website, and other units may refer to the list if they want to hire a work-study student to maintain their websites. The qualifications for being hired as a work-study student for campus website maintenance are valid for a period of two years after the aforesaid list is announced online.
- Article 5 Matters not mentioned herein, if any, shall be subject to the applicable regulations and rules of the University.
- Article 6 The Regulations become effective on the third day of promulgation after being adopted by the University Administration Council and ratified by the President.

Note: In the event of any disputes or misunderstanding as to the interpretation of the language or terms of the Regulations, the Chinese language version shall prevail.
