Western language	Britannica Academic	<p>The database includes four encyclopedias: Encyclopedia Britannica, Britannica Student Encyclopedia, Britannica Elementary Encyclopedia, and Britannica Concise Encyclopedia. It provides access to over 225,000 articles, over 23,000 biographies, and over 27,000 illustrations, maps, and graphs, as well as over 3,300 animations and videos. Additionally, users can access nearly a thousand journals such as Buddhist-Christian Studies, Education Digest, and USA Today Magazine.</p>
Western language	EBSCO (ASP+BSC)	<p>ASP ( Academic Search Premier ) is the world's largest multidisciplinary full-text database covering diverse academic research areas. Many of the full-text journals included in this database are also indexed in the three major citation databases of the Institute for Scientific Information (ISI) in the United States, namely the Science Citation Index Expanded (SCIE), Social Sciences Citation Index (SSCI), and Arts and Humanities Citation Index (A&amp;HCI). This database is widely used by international academic research institutions and covers a diverse range of academic research areas, including politics, business and economics, information science, technology, communication, engineering, education, art, literature, linguistics, medicine and women's studies, nursing, humanities and social sciences, with more than twice as many journals as the popular ASE database. It indexes/abstracts nearly 8,420 publications (of which approximately 6,879 are peer-reviewed) and provides access to about 4,459 full-text publications (of which approximately 3,619 are peer-reviewed) that are updated monthly. The database also provides high-quality, searchable (native) PDF full-text format files.</p> <p>BSC (Business Source Complete) is one of EBSCO's most comprehensive full-text databases of business and finance. Many well-known full-text journals are included in the ranking of SCI business and finance, such as Strategic Management Journal, Psychology &amp; Marketing, Journal of Business Ethics, Journal of Business &amp; Psychology, Human Resource Management, Journal of Forecasting, Marketing Letters, Journal of Risk &amp; Uncertainty, etc. Many famous business schools in the United States, such as Harvard University, Stanford University, University of Chicago, Northwestern University, University of Pennsylvania (Wharton), have subscribed to and highly used this resource. It includes over 10,000 full-text publications and has recently added 55 Harvard Business School seminar videos featuring renowned scholars and professors from Harvard Business School discussing various topics.</p>

It can organize and manage materials such as images, tables, and image data, and can store electronic full-text documents in the EndNote reference management software. EndNote is a software tool for creating bibliographies and drafts, and can be used to format citations, tables, and other data in Microsoft Word. When inserting citations into a draft article, EndNote can create a reference and table list at the end of the document.</p>
Western language	JCR on Web(Science Edition Social Science Edition)	<p>The internet-based journal citation statistics database system developed for Clarivate (formerly known as Thomson Reuters) provides citation analysis information for 254 subject areas in science, social sciences, humanities and arts, as well as emerging scientific fields, covering over 114 countries and more than 21,000 journals. The system collects citation data from the Science Citation Index Expanded™ (SCIE) and the Social Sciences Citation Index™ (SSCI) databases for a period of at least three years (some are not subject to this limit) for the purpose of ranking journals. The data is updated annually in the summer for the previous year. This system allows users to understand a journal's overall academic performance in a particular topic, year, or country, and helps libraries, publishers, journal editors, and academic authors manage and utilize academic journals.</p>

Western language	Primal Pictures 3D interactive human anatomy database	The Primal Pictures 3D Interactive Anatomy database is published by Informa UK Limited, based in the United Kingdom. It includes modules such as 3D ATLAS, 3D Real Time, Functional Anatomy and Therapy, Anatomy & Physiology, Imaging, Clinical Specialties, and Quizzes. These modules provide information on basic physiology, anatomical images, and detailed anatomical descriptions, as well as guidance on ultrasound, MRI, and CT medical image interpretation. The database also includes clinical topics such as dentistry, speech and language therapy, physiotherapy, sports medicine, surgery, and acupuncture. The Primal Pictures Anatomy database provides diverse materials to offer professional basic and clinical medical information, which facilitates clinical work and self-learning for educators. The 3D Real Time module also provides an app function for easy accessibility to learning.
Western language	ProQuest Central	ProQuest Central is a database that covers 47 ProQuest databases and contains approximately 32,840 abstracts, of which around 25,170 are full-text publications. It is the largest single-journal resource that brings together complete databases in all major subject areas, including business, health and medicine, language and literature, social sciences, education, science and technology, as well as core subjects in the performing and visual arts, history, religion, and philosophy. It includes thousands of full-text newspapers from around the world.
Western language	Science Direct Online (SDOL)	This database collects full-text electronic journals published by Elsevier, covering topics such as agriculture, biology, biochemistry, genetics, molecular biology, immunology, microbiology, chemistry, chemical engineering, medicine, pharmacy, pharmaceuticals, dentistry, veterinary medicine, computer science, earth and planetary sciences, engineering, energy, technology, environmental science, materials science, mathematics, physics, astronomy, management, accounting, psychology, business, economics, econometrics, finance, social sciences, arts and humanities, etc. The full-text download is only available online for electronic journals subscribed by our institution through the SDOL platform.
Western language	Turnitin plagiarism detection system	The Turnitin system for checking the originality of papers allows for online grading and applying standard and customized comments to students' papers. The sources used for Turnitin comparison include English language academic journal resources such as CrossRef (CrossCheck), which includes ACM, BMJ Publishing Group, Elsevier, IEEE, Nature Publishing Group, Oxford University Press, Sage, Wiley Blackwell, Springer, Sage, Am. Institute of Physics, Am. Physical Society, AAAS, ACS, Nature, etc. For Chinese language sources, any publicly available and free Chinese webpages, such as Chinese Wikipedia, Google in Chinese, Yahoo, etc. can be compared.
Chinese language	Airiti Library 華藝線上圖書館 (CEPS+CETD)	"The integration of two databases, CEPS (Chinese Electronic Periodicals Service) and CETD (Chinese Electronic Theses and Dissertations Service): CEPS is an online full-text service for various types of periodicals primarily in the Chinese language. The collection includes periodicals from Taiwan, Mainland China, Hong Kong, and other global locations that primarily use the Chinese language, but not limited to this language. CETD collects Master's and doctoral theses primarily in the Chinese language from higher education institutions in Taiwan, Mainland China, Hong Kong, and Macau."
Chinese language	TEJ (Taiwan Economic Journal)	Taiwan Economic Journal (TEJ) Cultural Enterprise Company was established in April 1990. Its main focus is on providing financial and securities market information in the Asia region, including Taiwan, mainland China, Hong Kong, Thailand, Korea, Singapore, the Philippines, and Malaysia. TEJ aims to assist users in understanding corporate information and financial statements in Asia, providing information for financial market analysis in three major areas: operating status, market performance, and market participants' opinions. In addition, TEJ offers several specialized databases with added value for academic research.
